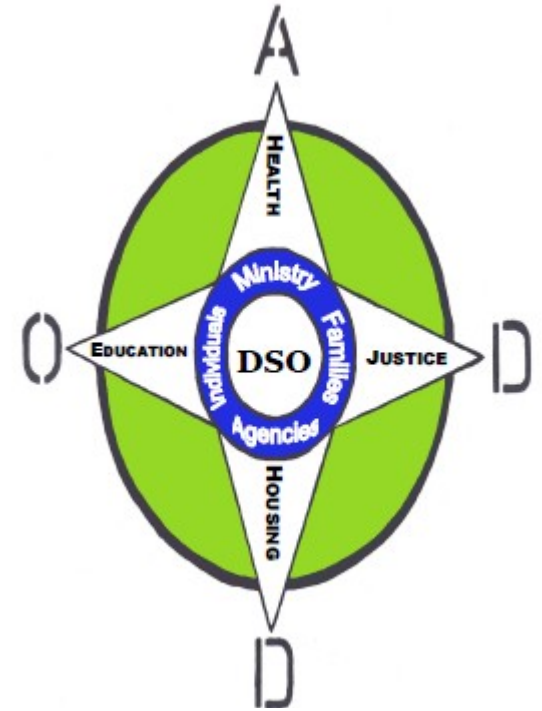

**The Evolution of Autism as a Diagnostic Entity: My Journey In It**

M. Mary Konstantareas, Ph. D. has conducted research in the use of augmentative communication approaches, factors affecting parental stress and coping in families of children with ASD, and etiological factors in the genesis of ASD. She will talk about the history of autism diagnosis, as well as the many etiologies of Autistic Disorder. Also addressed will be co-morbidity and dual diagnosis, including treatment implications.

**Mortality Patterns in Individuals with Developmental Disabilities**

Dr. McCreary, Professor Emeritus at Queen’s University and founder of the Division of Developmental Disabilities at Queen’s will review observations on 275 deaths at Rideau Regional Centre occurring between 1979 and 2009. Longevity and causes of death are considered in relation to the challenges now faced in Ontario as persons with developmental disabilities are integrated in mainstream healthcare services.
