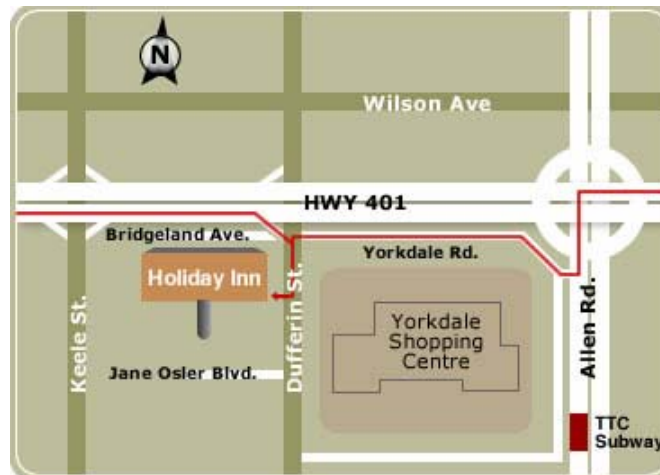
### What is a transferable Pass?

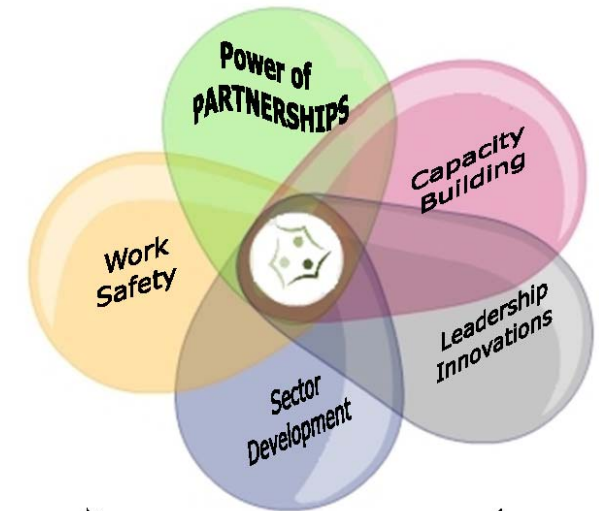
